

Veteran Division -Age 6 Rules

- Games are scheduled for 3 innings or 75 minutes long, whichever comes first.
- No score will be kept.
- The bases are set 50 feet apart, please try to do your best to measure accurately (many of your phones have a measuring app built in). Not all games will be played on an actual infield.
- A tee will be used for the first 2 games of the season, please be consistent. During the 3rd game, all coaches will begin pitching to players. This will take place after your 2nd scheduled game is complete. If a child wants to use a batting T throughout the season, they can do so.
- During coach pitch, if a player does not make contact after swinging and missing at 3 pitches, the player will then use the batting tee. (no strikeouts) Foul tips will not count as a missed swing (3 missed pitches, no more please stay consistent when you bring out the T for all players). Parents are watching how many pitches their child gets.
- Every player bats every inning. An inning is over when every player has batted once. Outs do not matter. Rotate who leads off and bats last every inning.
- At this level, when outs are recorded, pop fly is caught, put out at first base or other bases, players do not continue running the bases. They are out, outs do not count, every batter will continue to bat each inning. If 3 outs are recorded in one inning you will still continue to allow every player to have an at bat that inning.
- All batters must wear a batting helmet. (Parents can provide a helmet, however teams will have them as well.)
- There are no walks or strikeouts.
- The ball must travel 5 feet, or it is foul.
- No stealing. Runners must stay on their base until the ball is hit.
- Every player will play in the field each inning. Please make sure you rotate positions.
- Players are not allowed to play the same position for more than one inning during a game.
- There will be no catchers/players playing first base must wear a helmet. (Collisions with first basemen and batter sometimes happen.)
- Players can advance to the appropriate number of bases when the ball is struck. Example If the ball is hit in the
 outfield, players can take more than one base. No player should continue advancing to bases when the ball is in the
 infield.
