

COVID-19 Rules – Winchester Recreation Department/Jumpstart Basketball

COVID-19 Rules/Guidelines -All rules and procedures related to COVID-19 protection will be compliant with the processes set forth by Winchester Rec. (Guidelines are subject to change by Winchester Recreation Staff/Board of Health):

-Parents/guardians will drop off their child and asked a set of questions each day to make sure they do not show symptoms of COVID-19. Parents/guardians should not be bringing their child if there are any symptoms of COVID-19 or recent interactions with anyone who has tested positive of COVID-19.

-While waiting for your session to begin, we ask that all players/parents are adhering to social distancing guidelines of 6ft or staying in the car until the start time of the program. After dropping off your child/checking in, we ask parents/guardians to leave the courts, if need be, parents can watch outside of the courts. All participants/parents must be wearing a mask/covering upon arrival.

-Face masks/coverings must be worn on the court when social distancing of 6ft cannot be obtained. During any type of game play masks MUST be worn.

-Coaches are required to wear masks/coverings at ALL times.

-Participants should bring their own basketball to use. If a player does not have a basketball, please let us know in advance so we can make sure he or she has one.

-Participants should bring plenty of water. We will have some extra water if necessary, however coaches ONLY will fill the water bottles up using gloves that will be disposed of after use.

-We will remind/encourage all participant to use hand sanitizer before/after each session and during program breaks. Participants should bring their own bottle of hand sanitizer/wipes – sanitizer will be on-site if needed.

-If any cones/equipment are used, they will be sanitized after each session by coaches

-During the skills/drills, participants will be spread out/split up evenly to each of the six basketball hoops. There will be a maximum of six players per hoop for drills.

-There will be no high fives, handshakes, or fist bumps - we will find other ways to celebrate great work.

-There will be no use of public restrooms so please be sure to use the bathroom prior to attending.

-All participants will be asked to leave the courts after their session has finished so that the next group can start. Participants will be asked to wear their mask and/or maintain social distancing guidelines when leaving the courts.
